



# ARNG Instagram Carousel Canva Templates

These Canva templates are designed to help you quickly create clean, on-brand carousel posts for your state's Instagram account. Each template is built around a proven content format and includes flexible, editable elements you can customize in minutes.

## How to Access the Canva Templates

You **do not need edit access** to the original file.  
If you request access, it means one of the steps below was skipped.

### **Before you click the link**

- Make sure you are logged into Canva using your email

### **Step-by-step**

1. Click the template link
2. Confirm you are logged into Canva
3. Select **Copy design** in the top right
4. Edit **your copied version** only

If you see a screen asking to "Request access," **stop**.  
That means you are not logged in or did not click **Copy design**.

## Template Links

**Carousel Cover Template:** Use this as the first slide in any carousel. Add a bold hook or headline to stop the scroll and preview what the post is about.

**Soldier Feature (Photo Dump + Text Overlay):** A multi-image layout with space for quotes, captions, or key takeaways. Great for "day in the life" stories, event recaps, or ROTC features.

**Soldier Feature (Freeze Frame Style):** Comic-style layout designed for action shots, screenshots, or Reels content turned into a story.

**MOS Collage Template (Color + B&W versions):** Drag-and-drop grid layout to showcase multiple Guard roles in one post. Use the color or black-and-white version to match your tone.

**Motivational Quote Template:** Pair a powerful quote with a Guard image to create scroll-stopping, shareable content.



### **Helpful Designer Notes:**

- All templates are built with movable, layered elements for easy editing and rearranging.
- We're using Roboto Mono, a close match to the Guard's Monospec brand font, to keep everything on-brand and legible.
- For the Carousel Cover Template, the layout works like a picture frame: Send the frame to the back to change the image, then bring it forward to keep the design intact.
